The money we have raised is 100% restricted for the purchase of the Sunset Rock property, the necessary improvements, and maintenance to ensure we meet the mission of the Assembly consistent with our master plan.

With current and future gifts, we will be able to open up the view Assembly families have historically enjoyed and enhance the surrounding amenities. We are now setting our sites on a new goal of \$2,000,000 by January 15, 2024! All gifts and pledges received by January 15th will be recognized on a plaque located near sunset rock.
